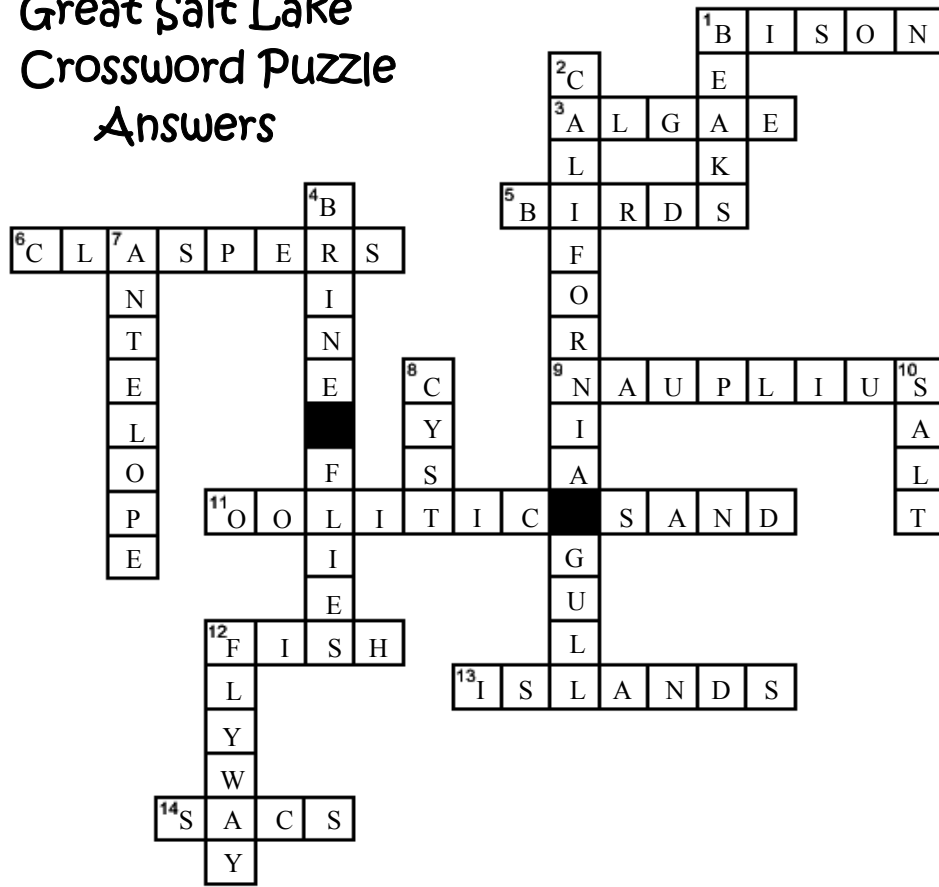
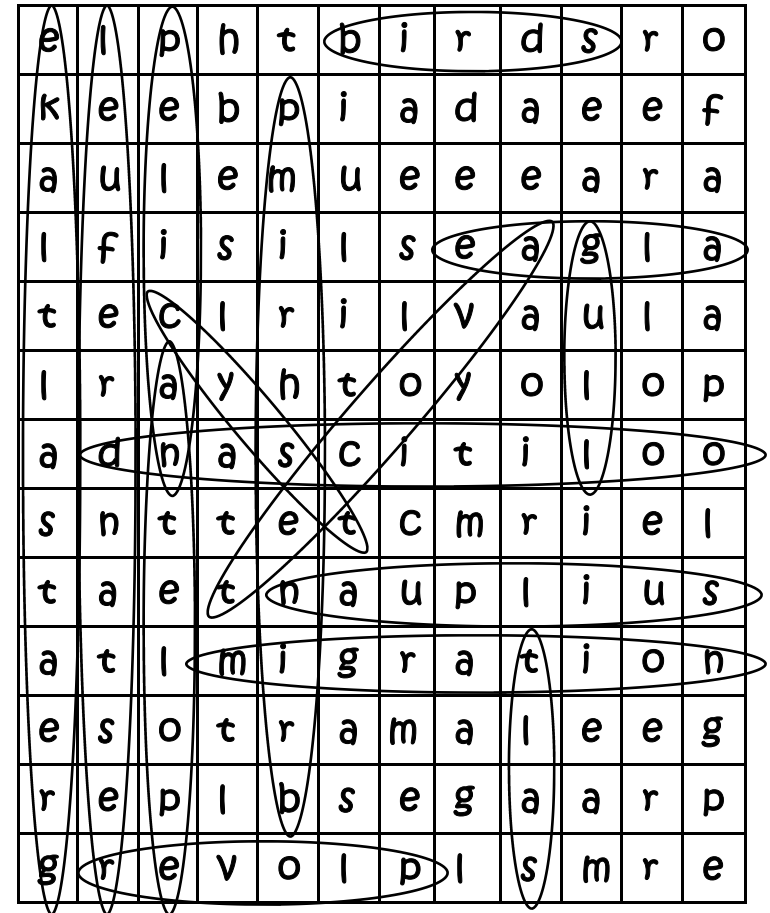


Great Salt Lake Crossword Puzzle Answers
