Utah YHEC Basics- Equipment Rules

<u>22 LR</u>

22 LR caliber only

3-9 scope only allowed. Scope may not have a power greater than 9X.

Minimum trigger pull of 2 lbs.

Rifle and scope cannot weigh more than 8 lbs 8 oz.

No rangefinders will be allowed.

Archery

Compounds, recurve, and long bows are permitted.

No more than one stabilizer.

No stabilizers over 12 inches.

Field or target points only.

No rangefinders will be allowed.

Shotgun

Any shotgun 12 gauge or smaller.

Double targets will be thrown so a shotgun capable of holding at least 2 shells.

Shotgun shell shot size must be between 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 9.

Muzzleloaders

No scopes allowed (open or peep sights only)

.54 Caliber and smaller are allowed

Only pure lead bullets (ex. no copper plated)

No more than 60 grains of powder is allowed.

No Smokeless or Nitro Cellulose-based powders allowed.

No rangefinders will be allowed.

Written Exam

Not an open book test.

No forms of communication are allowed. (phones, cameras, video equipment, etc.)

Safety Trail

All materials or equipment will be provided at the state competition.

No books or materials allowed.

No forms of communication are allowed. (phones, cameras, video equipment, etc.)

Orienteering

A pacing chart is permitted.

No calculators.

No forms of communication are allowed. (phones, cameras, video equipment, etc.)

No electronic equipment or battery operated compasses.

Wildlife ID

No forms of communication are allowed. (phones, cameras, video equipment, etc.)

No Reference materials allowed.
