The Utah Anglers Coalition (UAC) is Utah based nonprofit corporation consisting of many different angler groups and organizations, retailers, guides, and fishing industry representatives throughout the state.

The UAC supports the proposed changes to the Private Pond Rule (R657-59). More specifically, we feel that the current rule is cumbersome, difficult to read, and outdated and support the restructuring and simplification of the rule as proposed by the Division. We also support current triploid testing protocols required by the State of Utah and oppose any efforts by private growers to introduce less stringent triploid testing methods. In addition, we support expansion of the list of species that private growers may raise and stock into screened waters. Furthermore, we support inclusion of language in the rule that clearly states the criminal penalty (Class A Misdemeanor) for violations of the rule. This is already stated in state code, but adding it to the rule helps the division with enforcement efforts.

UAC is strongly supportive of UDWR efforts to protect sport fish and native fish populations from escapement of privately stocked fish. Protection of sport fish resources and native species conservation are key priorities for our group.
