However, I would decrease the amount of out of state tags from 10% to 5%. I would also like the throw out the idea of adding a similar law that Arizona has for harvesting bears. Arizona has a quota for sows, once that quota for that unit is met, the hunt closes the following Wednesday. Each unit had a sow quota for each season. Another idea is adding a "conservation fee of 50% of the tag fee" if a sow/female cat is taken instead of a boar or tom. This will allow the hunters to be more mindful of the gender of the species that is being taken. Hunters will pay more attention to the bear orientation that needs to be taken every year. I don't feel like it would hurt to have a lion orientation as well. I feel like we need to try a little harder to protect our sows, female lions and cubs.
